

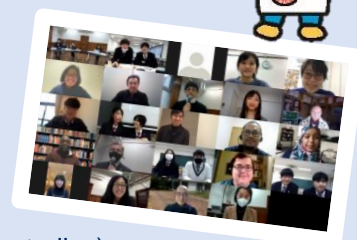
# The 6th **Kobe** Community Forum
